Like driving a car, driving a school bus requires the driver's attention. Students who have the privilege of riding the bus are expected to do their part to make every bus run a safe run. ### **ALL BAND STUDENTS MUST RIDE TO AND FROM COMPETITIONS ON THE BUS**

All students are expected to:

- ✓ Follow directions from the bus driver and coach
- ✓ Remain seated at all times
- ✓ Keep all parts of their body and any objects inside the bus
- ✓ Keep their hands and feet to themselves
- ✓ Use good manners, speak politely, and keep their voices down
- ✓ NOT BRING ANY FOOD OR DRINKS ON THE BUS
- ✓ Be at the pick-up point on time

Consequences:

If a student chooses to break a rule, a Bus Conduct Report will be written by the driver and given to the principal. The principal will respond in writing on this report to the driver and parents. Misconduct may lead to suspension from the bus.

Please discuss these bus rules and consequences with your student to be sure they understand the behavior that is expected of them. With your cooperation and support, they will have a safe journey to and from school.

As noted above, if any of the uniform has been lost or damaged, the student will be responsible for the cost of the lost or damaged item using the schedule of fees below:

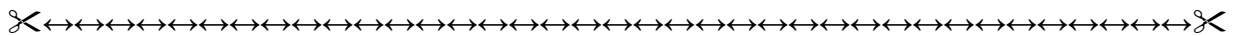

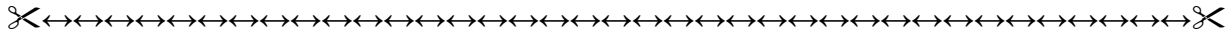
## MARCHING UNIFORMS AND SHOES

The South Lake School District has purchased uniforms for the Marching Band. Students will be fitted for uniforms prior to our performances.

**ALL Band students will be required to purchase their own:**

- A. **Black Socks - MUST be worn when in Marching Uniform. Socks must completely cover ankles.**
- B. **BLACK MARCHING SHOES** - (Order form attached).

Shoe costs are \$25, including shipping. Marching shoes must be considered part of our uniform and are necessary to protect students' feet and knees from the types of stress and injury incurred while marching. These shoes are specially designed to aid and protect students' in marching while ensuring proper foot and knee alignment. Order forms for shoe orders are attached. 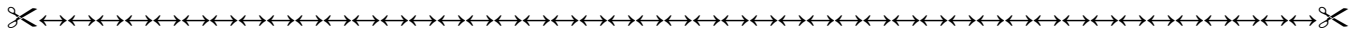

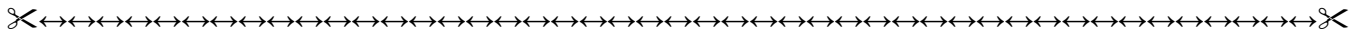

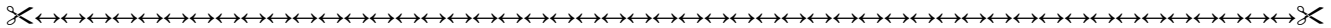
**CAMP RULES:  
PARENTS AND STUDENTS, PLEASE READ THIS  
SECTION CAREFULLY!**

The rules listed below should be thoroughly understood by both students and parents. All parents should read this list carefully and go over it with your children. These rules will be the same for all band activities throughout the school year. **The South Lake Schools Code of Conduct will be in effect.**

- Avoid behavior that is potentially injurious to any individual including you, or detrimental to the welfare of the band. **BE EARLY TO ALL ACTIVITIES.** This will contribute to our success at camp and throughout the year.
- DO NOT LEAVE YOUR CABIN OR ROOM WITHOUT PERMISSION.
- All students are responsible for the cleaning and maintenance of the cabins and general camp facilities. Those who litter or fail to do his/her fair share to keep our camp clean will be subject to disciplinary action.
- Use good sense and manners in the dining hall.
- **WATCH YOUR LANGUAGE!!!!**
- Do not embarrass yourself and others with public displays of affection.
- **NO GIRLS IN THE GUYS' AREA OR GUYS IN THE GIRLS' AREA AT ANY TIME!!! No one is allowed in anyone's cabin except their own.**
- Respect the property of other band members, the school, and the camp at all times. YOU BREAK IT; YOU PAY FOR THE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT.
- **Cell Phones are allowed at camp and should only be used in your own cabin during free time. NO CELL PHONES ARE ALLOWED OUTSIDE OF THE CABINS, ON THE PRACTICE FIELD, AT SECTIONALS OR AT PLANNED SOCIAL EVENTS!**
- South Lake Schools and the South Lake Band Boosters are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- **NO VISITORS AT CAMP FOR ANY REASON PER STATE LAW.** Students will not be allowed to leave camp for any length of time.

THE FOLLOWING BEHAVIORS WILL RESULT IN DISCIPLINARY ACTION. INFRACTIONS COULD LEAD TO THE STUDENT BEING SENT HOME AT THE PARENTS' EXPENSE AND/OR SUSPENDED FROM THE BAND INDEFINITELY:

- SMOKING OR USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS
- USE OF ALCOHOL OR CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES (Bags will be inspected)
- DISOBEDIENCE OR RUDENESS (BACK TALK) TO ANY STAFF MEMBER OR CHAPERONE
- LEAVING CABIN AFTER LIGHTS OUT
- UNEXCUSED ABSENCE FROM ANY BAND CAMP ACTIVITY

## PACKING LIST WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

Personal items should be marked with students' name.

### INSTRUMENT AND MUSIC NEEDS

- Instrument in good playing condition – **Extra Reeds, Valve Oil, Slide Grease, Etc.** – Reeds and repairs will not be available at camp.
- 3 Ring Binder with music and page protectors for drill and music.
- Folding music stand with name on both sections.
- Spring clip clothes pins for windy rehearsals
- Field Markers
- Writing utensil (pens or pencils)

### CLOTHING NEEDS

Cool clothing for field work (shorts, t-shirts, etc. must be loose enough to permit freedom of movement required for marching).

- Two pair of good athletic shoes, no sandals allowed for marching - **This is a must to help avoid foot and ankle injuries.**
- Several pair of socks (in case of wet weather, 2 pair per day)
- Underwear (plan extras in case of wet weather)
- Sweats for colder nights (campfires)
- Shorts
- Tee Shirts
- Pajamas
- Light Jacket for evenings
- Raincoat or poncho
- Hat
- Swimsuit

### PERSONAL ITEMS

- One reasonably sized suitcase, one carry on bag and instrument. **Absolutely no trunks or footlockers will be permitted.**
- Bedding – twin size sheets, blankets (or sleeping bags), pillow
- Towels, wash cloths, soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen/Sunblock - an absolute must!
- Bug Spray
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- Snacks – individually packaged, healthy snacks such as cereal bars, energy bars, etc.
- Water Bottle
- Any Medications over the counter & prescriptions. (All medications must be in checked in prior to departure, in their original container.)**

## **WHAT NOT TO BRING**

- NO BOOM BOXES** - If you want to listen to music, bring Discman or MP3 and headphones. South Lake Schools and the South Lake Band Boosters are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- NO TV's, laptops, gaming systems or other electronic devices.**
- NO Pop, juice or soft drinks are allowed in the cabins as they are messy. WATER ONLY.**
